COVID Info & Procedures

- We are doing our best to provide online and/or physically distanced worship/activities while following safety recommendations.
- Masks required—covering nose & mouth per Zion's COVID Plan and MN Mandate. Children under 2 exempt, 2-5 encouraged.
- Stay physically distanced—6 feet apart.
- Please use hand sanitizer and/or wash hands.
- If you or a family member have symptoms, are sick or exposed to a case, please stay home! Symptoms can include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache, muscle pain, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or loss of taste or smell. Gastrointestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting or diarrhea are less common.
- If you test positive and have recently been at church while infectious, please contact the office.
- We are open for small groups with safety protocols required—you <u>must</u> be scheduled with the office for potential contact tracing. <u>NEW!</u> No food or beverages consumed in the building.
- MN Dept. of Health recommends people at high-risk (over 65 or underlying medical conditions) stay home. The CDC has info too.
- Church Council evaluates monthly. Watch for updates. See <u>Zion's</u>
 <u>COVID Plan</u> for detailed info. <u>NE MN Synod</u> recommends a
 conservative approach for the health and wellbeing of members.
